## BMCC HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT DUAL ENROLLMENT BOARD OF REGENTS TUITION AWARD

The Board of Regents Tuition Award from the Bay Mills Community College exempts tribal high school students, applying as dual-enrolled students, from paying tuition for the summer semester. This waiver is specific to the summer term, requires an application for each enrollment period, and excludes coverage for registration, student fees, and textbook expenses.

The Board of Regents Tuition Award is accessible to tribal high school students who are enrolled in summer classes at BMCC and satisfy the following criteria:

- a) Must be a member of a U.S. Federally Recognized Tribe and **a copy of your Tribal I.D. or verification of Tribal membership from your Tribal Enrollment Clerk is on file at BMCC.**
- b) Must maintain a 2.0 Grade Point Average.
- c) Students must display good moral character to remain eligible (the BMCC student handbook defines acceptable student behavior).

A student who fails to attain a minimum 2.0 BMCC cumulative GPA in the dual enrollment program and later enrolls at BMCC as a regular student after graduation may discover that their dual enrollment GPA could negatively affect their eligibility for financial aid.

The Board of Regents Tuition Award is limited to a maximum of two (2) classes per summer semester but in no case more than eight (8) credits per summer.
