

Articulation Agreement

Offered collaboratively by

Bay Mills Community College

and

Kirtland Community College

for

Surgical Technology Associate in Applied Science Degree

Scope of Program:

Bay Mills Community College (BMCC) and Kirtland Community College (KCC) for its Associate in Applied Science Degree- Surgical Technology agree to establish a cooperative agreement of presurgical technology/surgical technology education by which BMCC students completing the Health Science certificate degree at BMCC will receive entry into KCC's Surgical Technology Associate in Applied Science Degree. This agreement shall become effective upon the last dated signature $\frac{12}{6}$ 2023.

Program Articulation:

This articulation is intended for students seeking an Associate in Applied Science in surgical technology at Kirtland Community College. Students completing a Health Science Certificate at Bay Mills Community College and earning a C or above in each course therein, will be eligible to apply for admission to the Surgical Technology Program at Kirtland Community College. Upon completion of the program courses and the meeting of all graduation requirements, Kirtland Community College will award an Associate in Applied Science Degree in Surgical Technology. This degree will lead to a recommendation for the student to sit for the National Certification Examination to become a Certified Surgical Technologist (CST).

Responsibilities:

Bay Mills Community College agrees to:

- Engage in broad-based outreach to identify, recruit, and develop potential students in the Health Science Certificate degree program and to monitor the progress of these students to ensure their continued qualification toward completion of the Health Science Certificate.
- 2. Advertise and make accessible this agreement to all current potential students at BMCC.
- 3. Identify and engage BMCC students who are first generation college students, graduates from low-income high schools, PELL, or institutional need-based grant eligible or recipient, graduate of an underserved urban or rural area high school.

- 4. Make KCC application requirements known to students.
- 5. Ensure continued course offerings for the appropriate academic preparation of students, for transfer to KCC.
- 6. Facilitate engagement between students and KCC advising and other developmental opportunities.

Kirtland Community College agrees to:

- 1. Communicate with BMCC regarding transfer expectations and transferable pre-surgical technology courses.
- 2. Invite BMCC student participation in KCC advising for the Associate in Applied Science degree in the Surgical Technology program.
- Assign an Academic Advisor to identify and offer advising and academic support to transfer students who are first generation college students, graduates from low-income high schools, PELL or institutional need-based grant eligible or recipient, graduate of an underserved urban or rural area high school.
- 4. Ensure continued course offerings for the Associate in Applied Science degree in the Surgical Technology program to completion.
- 5. Permit BMCC students to self-identify for consideration as a KCC applicant.
- 6. Grant an Associate in Applied Science degree to each Surgical Technology student upon successful completion of KCC graduation requirements.

Program Publicity:

Both institutions agree that all program materials, media releases, and interview comments concerning this articulation agreement shall be mutually approved prior to publication, release, or comment, which such approval will not be unreasonably withheld. Both institutions agree that all program materials will be made available to both institutions for use and distribution upon request.

Length of Agreement:

The parties commit to a review every two years. The agreement shall be reviewed in the fall of 2025. Upon satisfactory review of the agreement conditions and effectiveness, the agreement may be renewed through a new agreement or amendment. The agreement may be suspended or revoked only upon written request by either institution with sixty (60) day advance notice to: an administrative representative from BMCC and an administrative representative from KCC. Should either institution provide a written request for suspension or revocation, any student currently in progress toward the Health Science Certificate at BMCC shall be permitted to continue.
