## HYBRID COURSES

A hybrid course is a course that combines approximately 50% "face-to-face" instruction with 50% online computer based learning. A significant part of the course learning is online and the amount of classroom seat-time is reduced. The course content and the course work does not change with hybrid status, it remains the same. Before taking a hybrid course it is recommended that students are competent at the CS121 Principles of Microsoft Office level.
