IV
PURPOSES

The purpose of the Corporation are as follows:

- Section 1. To provide educational programs, to establish and operate educational institutions at the post-secondary level on the Bay Mills Indian Community.
- Section 2. To operate exclusively for, non-profit purposes; and no part of the income or assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to, nor inure to the benefit of, any individual.
- Section 3. To serve the post-secondary educational needs of Michigan Indians off campus when requested and approved by the Bay Mills Community College Board of Regents.
- Section 4. To issue contracts as provided by Parts 6a or 6b of the Michigan School Code of 1976 or the Michigan revised School Code and to cooperate with the Michigan State Board of Education, the Michigan Department of Education, any school district or public school academy in the State of Michigan in the provision of public education in Michigan
